Information on How to Stain My Front Door

Lots #1 - #45

- **Stain:** Provincial Mini Wax Stain
- **Sealer:** Helman's Mini Wax Spar urethane Clear Gloss
- **Directions:**
 - Lightly sand the door with a medium grit (100 grit) sand paper.
 - Wipe the door with paint thinner.
 - If you do this often enough, you will not have to stain the door as often.
 - If the door is sun beaten, stain lighter spots first and then apply the stain on entire door.

Lots #46 - #60

- **Stain:** S.W. Wood Classic – Classic Cherry
- **Sealer:** Helman's Mini Wax Spar urethane Clear Gloss
- **Directions:**
 - Lightly sand the door with a medium grit (100 grit) sand paper.
 - Wipe the door with paint thinner.
 - If you do this often enough, you will not have to stain the door as often.
 - If the door is sun beaten, stain lighter spots first and then apply the stain on entire door.

*If you follow these instructions, your front door should only have to be stained once every 1-2 years.
